The City of Dakota City records regarding burials are limited to certain pieces of information. There are no other Vital Records held at city hall. The staff will be glad to assist you with any inquiry.



DAKOTA CITY CEMETERY INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS



Burial Arrangements

Arrangements for burial can be made by calling Dakota City Hall at (402) 987-3448. Payment for plot and opening and closing must be made in full prior to burial service.

Cemetery Hours

The cemetery is open to the public 8 a.m. to dusk.

Violations

Any such violation of the cemetery policy shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$100. Each day that a violation continues shall constitute a separate violation with fine.

Lots

Lots are maintained by the lot owner and or family. The City of Dakota City maintains the mowing and tree maintenance. Please inform City of Dakota City if there are any other issues regarding cemetery lots and grounds upkeep.

Work Requirements

No work may be done on cemetery grounds unless approved by the cemetery sexton.

Forty-Eight hours' notice along with cemetery approval is required for stones to be set, reset, or repaired on cemetery grounds

No unauthorized driving on cemetery roads. Permission to drive on cemetery grounds **MUST** be obtained PRIOR to work being done.

Burial Lot Size

Adult Space	5'x10'
Baby land Cremation Space.....	2'x5'
Cremation Space	2'x2.5'

Memorials

- **Flat Memorials** (No height memorial stones): Flat memorials must be flush with the ground.
- **Only one memorial stone** stating the name of the deceased is permitted on a grave space. Exception: A Veterans' stone with the same name as the original memorial stone may be placed at the foot of the grave as a companion stone.
- **Temporary memorial stones** are allowed for six months following the interment.
- **Vases** are limited to two (2) per memorial stone.
- Memorial stones in the Northeast Addition must be flat memorial stones.
- **Home-made stone(s)** are not to be placed on graves.
- **Installation** of memorial stones, vases and repairs must be completed by a professional contractor.
- Any private persons or company **must obtain approval** from cemetery sexton before any type of project begins.
- **Memorials may be left up to 10 days after Memorial Day.** Please set memorials out prior to Memorial Day no sooner than one week prior due to weather and upkeep of cemetery.
